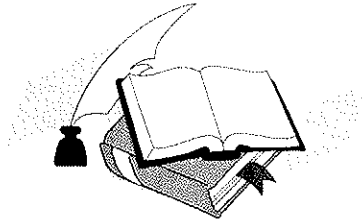

Associate Professor Bridget Robinson
"Blood Vessels and Cancer"

Bridget Robinson is Associate Professor in Medicine at the University of Otago Christchurch, and Medical Oncologist in the Oncology service, Christchurch Hospital. She trained in Christchurch and at the Royal Marsden Hospital, London, UK, returning to Christchurch in 1986. She has always been interested in research, and is the clinical director of the Angiogenesis and Cancer Research Group, which studies the blood vessels and other features of human cancers.

She was a key person in establishing the Cancer Society Tissue Bank to support cancer research, pre-eminent in New Zealand. Bridget has strong clinical interests in breast, colorectal, and other gastrointestinal cancers.

Her vision is to continue to develop research on the Christchurch campus which involves cancer patients, and to make the results readily accessible to our community.
